- What do you want to achieve through the presentation?

**Audience:**

- Think about how best to adapt your material to demonstrate your knowledge and to make it interesting to your teacher.

**Presentation Message:**

- What is the one key message that you would like to convey to your teacher? Think about what you have learned through this first segment of lessons.
- What is one piece of information that you feel is the most important?

**Create an outline that gives structure and content:**

- What is the structure of the presentation that will convey the important points you want to make about the needs of the underserved members of your community?

**Gather your information:** Because you have taken great notes throughout the lessons, all of your information should be listed in your notebook.
